1. This application is for enrolled tribal members of the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma only in high school 9th through 12th grades.
2. Program applications are always open, but direct service request have deadlines.
3. Please be sure all requested documents are submitted with direct service requests by the deadline.

Direct Service Request Deadlines for *Fall*: **June 30**, *Spring*: **December 1**, Summer: **May 1**
Absolutely **NO LATE APPLICATIONS** will be accepted or reviewed.

Eligibility Guidelines:

1. Must be an enrolled member of the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma
2. Completed program applications must be submitted to the ITO Higher Education department to be accepted to the program. Applicants must update initial program application each year if contact information has changed.
3. Applications for direct service requests will need to be submitted each semester and will follow the ITO scholarship deadlines of June 30th for the fall semester, December 1st for the spring semester, and May 1st for the summer funding consideration.
4. Applicant must be enrolled in the 9th through 12th grade to apply for the program and direct services.
5. Applicants must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA to apply for direct services but may have a lower GPA to apply for the initial program.
6. ITO tribal members of all grade point averages will be accepted to the ITO College Bridge Program as they work their way to the minimum qualifying 2.0 cumulative GPA to apply for direct services.
7. The ITO College Bridge Program will be open to qualifying ITO tribal members regardless of the residence location.

Maximum Direct Services:

- Freshman: (1) ACT/SAT per year; (1) AP Test fee per semester.
- Sophomore: (1) ACT/SAT per year; (2) AP Test fee per semester.
- Junior: (2) ACT/SAT per year; (2) AP Test fee per semester; (2) Concurrent classes per semester.
- Senior: (2) ACT/SAT per year; (2) AP Test fee per semester; (2) Concurrent classes per semester.
