PROGRAM INFORMATION

Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma Early Head Start program offers Early Care and Education services to children and families in Payne, Lincoln and Logan counties. Services include Center-based care for newborns through their 3rd birthday, Home-based services for families to receive Learning@Home with Early Head Start, and the Expectant Families program to engage and support mothers during pregnancy.

All services free and voluntary to families in Payne, Lincoln, and Logan Counties.

EXPECTANT FAMILIES PROGRAM

WHY SHOULD YOU ENROLL?

Expectant Families Program is a free comprehensive program designed to help eligible pregnant women receive the many services needed for a healthy pregnancy.

- Supportive weekly educational services in the comfort of your home for parents with children birth to 36 months.
- Information and support to understand your baby's growth and development.
- Tips and Tools to keep your baby safe and to help manage stress
- Early reading, writing and math skills supported through everyday play experiences
- Health, vision and dental screenings
- Group Socializations with other children and parents
- Ongoing reviews of your child's developmental progress

ABOUT

Early Head Start is designed to nurture attachments between parent and child (and child and caregivers). Services encompass the full range of a family's needs from pregnancy through a child's third birthday.

The facility is licensed through OKDHS and tribally operated by the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma.

SERVICES

- We accept children from birth to 3 years of age
- Additional hours are available from 7AM to 6PM
- Offer Services for Infants and Toddlers with Special Needs
- · No application fee
- Surveillance cameras onsite
- DHS Title XX assistance accepted for before and after care
- Diapers, wipes, formula and baby food provided.
 Toddlers are provided breakfast, lunch, and snack from a dietitian approved menu free of charge
