WHAT IS THE COLLEGE BRIDGE PROGRAM?

The mission of the College Bridge Program is to assist Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma tribal members 9th through 12th grade as they seek preparation for entrance into higher education institutions. Students of all academic levels are encouraged to apply. The College Bridge Program will offer academic guidance and mentorship opportunities as well as direct services towards Advanced Placement (AP) exams, ACT/SAT exams, and Concurrent classes. Program participants will agree to provide a copy of their academic transcript to the Higher Education Department after each semester. *Program applications are always open, but direct service requests have deadlines.* (Listed below)

- (2) ACT/SAT per year
- (2) AP test fee per semester
- (2) Concurrent classes per semester
