Sexual Assault Services Program

On January 1, 2013 The Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma was awarded a grant for a Tribal Sexual Assault Program (TSASP) in order to provide services to children, adolescents, adults and secondary victims of sexual assault who reside in Lincoln, Logan, and Payne counties. The grant will focus on tribal victims who have not reported and are in need of advocacy and/or help in healing from the assault.

Assistance Reporting the Attack, Assistance Accessing a Sexual Assault Nurse Examination (SANE), Safety Planning, Assistance with Protective Orders, Court Accompaniment, Case Management, Culturally Specific Advocacy, Counseling and Support Group Services for Victims and Their Families, Traditional Healing, Referral Services, and Community Outreach and Education.

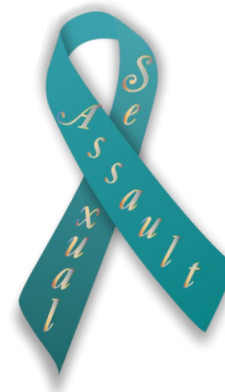

One out of three Native American Women are sexually assaulted and 2.5 times more likely to experience sexual assault crimes compared to all other races. Fifty four percent of Sexual Assaults are not reported to the police and approximately 2/3 of assaults are committed by someone known to the victim.

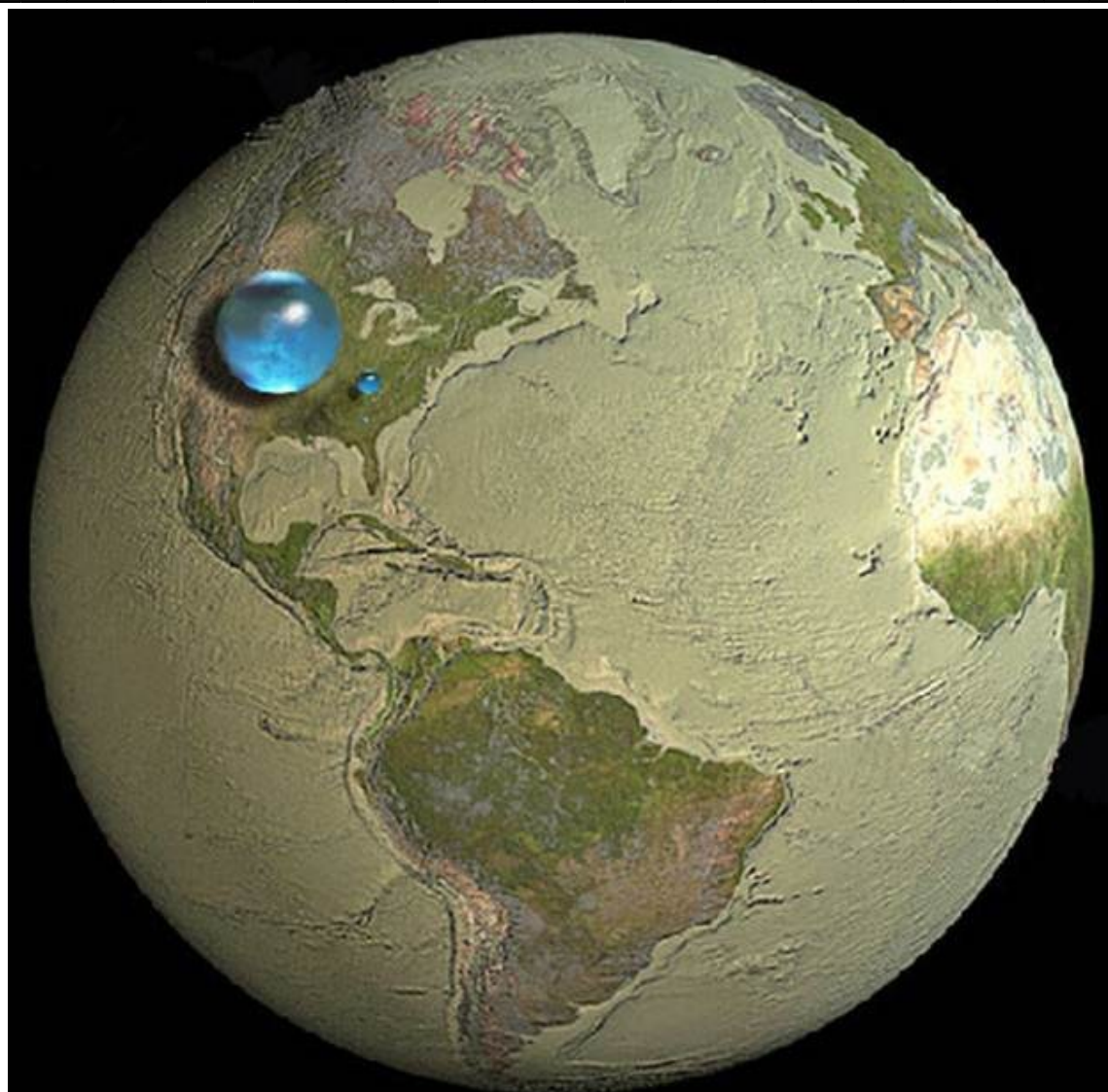

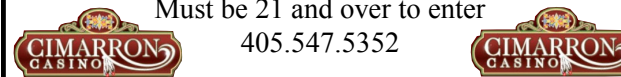

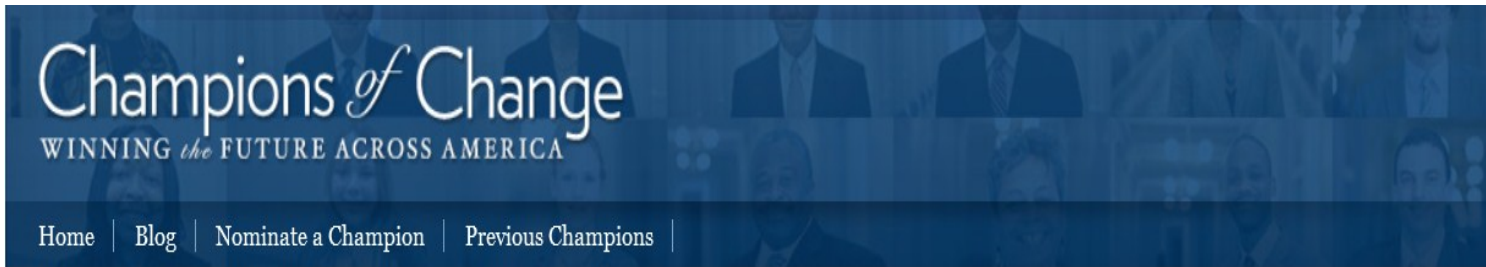

It recognizes an indigenous library that profoundly demonstrates outstanding service to its community. In three short years, the library evolved from an organization with no budget and no viable programs to a well-funded organization that is considered an "essential service." The library now is widely-recognized for its work in advancing print and digital literacy among young and old, providing resources in employment and health, as well as activities to help preserve the Iowa people's culture and history, and much more.
